Instruction :

It has come to our attention that certain external companies (and websites) are making claims as to ISP Appointed Service Stations being approved to service/maintain their product range.

For the sake of absolute clarity, please note the following:

Zipped Closure lifejackets require specific specialist training to ensure the correct and safe functioning of the lifejacket.

Only service stations who have received and successfully passed such specific training and are in possession of a Training Certificate that clearly states the "zipped model name" on it are trained and approved to carry out such servicing and maintenance work on ISP Products Only. If you have not received "zip closure" training specifically by ISP Personnel and are in receipt of an above mentioned Training Certificate, then you should decline to service the product and suggest they contact the manufacturer to return it to them.

Any service station that would like to receive such training should contact ISP for training course details and pricing.
